R E S O L U T I O N No. 16-EF-701

AMENDING THE APPROVAL OF A FINANCING OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL
FACILITIES CORPORATION (Clean Water State Revolving Fund -
Direct and Market Rate Financing Projects)

WHEREAS, the New York State Public Authorities Control Board ("PACB"), created pursuant to Chapter 38, Laws of 1976, as amended, is empowered by section 51 of the Public Authorities Law to receive applications from designated public benefit corporations, including the Environmental Facilities Corporation ("EFC"), for approval of the acquisition, construction or financing of any project by any such public benefit corporation; and

WHEREAS, the EFC submits from time to time applications to the PACB for approval of short-term and long-term financings as authorized in an EFC resolution duly adopted by the EFC Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, the PACB duly received an application from the EFC for approval of short-term direct/short-term market-rate financings (the "Financings") from available funding through the Clean Water State Revolving Fund duly adopted by Resolution No. 2217 (the "EFC Resolution") at a meeting of the EFC Board of Directors held on December 6, 2011; and

WHEREAS, on October 20, 2011 the PACB adopted Resolution No. 11-EF-550 (the "PACB Resolution"), approving the Financings; and

WHEREAS, the EFC Resolution and the PACB Resolution included a \$3,200,000 short-term interest-free financing to

the Village of Valatie (the "Village"); and

WHEREAS, the maximum five-year term of the financing authorized to the Village is set to mature on December 29, 2016; and

WHEREAS, EFC's staff has determined that an extension of the Village's financing is necessary in order to allow EFC's staff time to adequately assess the overall financial condition of the Village and properly prepare the required documents for conversion to long-term financing; and

WHEREAS, the PACB has received an application (the "Application") from the EFC seeking approval to extend the maturity of the financing to the Village for six months to June 28, 2017, as authorized in an EFC resolution duly adopted at a meeting of the EFC Board of Directors duly held on October 6, 2016; and

WHEREAS, all other authorizations contained in the PACB Resolution shall remain in effect; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the Application has been filed with the Comptroller, and he has had the opportunity to comment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the PACB approves the extension of the maturity of the financing to the Village to June 28, 2017, and as authorized in the PACB Resolution, in accordance with section 51 of the Public Authorities Law:


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
This resolution shall become effective immediately.




